

AT 401 – LEATHER & VINYL TREATMENT

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

AT 401 - Leather & Vinyl Treatment restores and protects leather and vinyl surfaces. It makes old vinyl and leather surfaces look like new. AT 401 is a two-in-one product that both cleans and protects almost any leather or vinyl surface. It leaves leather and vinyl soft, supple, flexible and protected from UV damage. No greasy or slippery residue. Perfect for automobiles, boats, furniture, leather accessories and boots.

2. APPLICATION

- Clean surface of any dirt or grime.
- Shake bottle well.
- Apply modest amount of AT 401 to a soft terry-cloth towel.
- Use a circular motion with moderate pressure to work AT 401 into the surface evenly.
- Let the coating absorb into the surface.
- As the coating is absorbed, it will continue to soften and protect the surface from weathering and UV damage.
- After a few minutes, if there is more product on an area than will absorb into the surface, just wipe off any excess coating or spread the excess amount over a larger area.
- Once AT 401 is absorbed into the surface, gently buff with a clean dry cloth to achieve a beautiful luster.
- New leather surfaces generally require one coat. Older, hardened leather or vinyl surfaces may require 2-3 coats. Let each application soak in and penetrate the material before applying the next coat.
- Re-apply as often as desired to keep leather and vinyl surfaces in premium condition.
- Note that AT 401 will not repair cracks in leather or vinyl surfaces. AT 401 will soften the area around cracks and thereby help to reduce future cracking.
- AT 401 may not always remove stubborn chemical stains.

3. STORAGE STABILITY & SHELF LIFE

- The shelf life is one year when stored in the original, unopened container. Store containers in a well-ventilated and covered area away from extreme heat and moisture. Contact your ALPHATEK representative if you have any questions about the products or its uses.
